e⁴ // The elliptical structure of its outer casing, composed of blades, serves simultaneously as a non-dazzle screen, a reflector of the central light source and a heat dissipater. Five pairs of polycarbonate interchangeable filters determine the varying colours of its lamellar body. In fact Titania can be coloured as desired, by a simple movement of the hand to slot the different filters in and out and to give the lamp a "dematerialised" colour - while always maintaining an emission of white light! The spherical counterweight, allowing its up-down adjustment, can be inserted or removed at any time.

e¹ // No. 4 is a back-pack with adjustable shoulder straps. For safe stowage, a zipper is provided in the back of the bag. The material is made from heavy-duty found tractor inner tubes (recycled), which are vigorously washed and virtually indestructible. The adjustable shoulder straps are and made from automobile seatbelts. A finer industrial bungee cord loop which allows for hand carrying is provided at the top of the bag. The height & shape of the bag relates directly its source as raw material inner tube, and the curvature of the inner tube provides a natural belly to the form.
